



#### Director's Message:

After many years of searching for an affordable, high-quality video streaming service for our community, we are happy to introduce a new collection of online movies and TV shows through Biblio+, an extension of our existing CloudLibrary App.

In addition to the eBooks and audiobooks you already love, CloudLibrary will now offer a curated video collection which includes many BBC titles, popular documentaries, foreign films (including a large Spanish language collection), Oscar winners and nominees, and so much more! These titles allow for concurrent use, meaning that you never have to wait to access video content. *Collection Highlights*:

- 2,300 films & TV episodes available
- 20 new releases added per week

CloudLibrary also recently added a "Kids Mode" which will offer the user the option of direct access to children's materials, skipping past the adult titles.

Finally, did you know that you can store your library card on the CloudLibrary App? By adding your barcode to the App, you'll be able to use your phone to check out at the circulation desk. Never again will you need to fumble through your wallet for your long-lost card!
