Collingswood Public Library recently experienced a digital makeover! The library launched its new website this March. Don't worry; the address is still the same: www.collingswoodlib.org.


The layout is bright, modern, and interactive. You can easily log in to your account and search the catalog from the homepage. Our programs and events are now front and center, and top news is easy to locate.

A little background: I started this project in the fall of 2019, when I participated in the New Jersey State Library UX (user experience) Design Boot Camp. Over a period of three months, I conducted a website audit, learned about user design, explored web hosting options, completed user testing, and practiced wireframe design. With a new framework in mind, the library board consulted with local design experts and found an excellent partnership with Ric at Mirus Development, LLC. Throughout 2020, I worked with Ric to develop a new website that would be (a) created with mobile users in mind, (b) clean and simple in design, while also attractive and responsive, and (c) intuitive. After months of development and testing, the website is now ready!

Please take a look and let us know where changes would be helpful. A website is an ever-changing organism, much like the library itself, and we always appreciate your feedback!




